

his project was for existing international clients who were downsizing from their large period London home and wanted a new fresh look in a contemporary setting. The penthouse apartment overlooks the River Thames with far reaching views of the Palace of Westminster down to the Tower of London and views of St Pauls. This light airy apartment is to be a pied a terre for use on their visits to the UK several times a month. The brief was to create a stunning contemporary interior, but a "real home", not the typical sterile interiors of the usual 'hotel suite' look.

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THE FINAL DELIGHT IS THE CINEMA ROOM, AGAIN USING THE SAME PALLETS AND MATERIALS, WITH THE CINEMA SEATING BEING CENTRE STAGE WITH JADES AND LAPIS VELVETS.



The main reception areas are open plan and the look to be created was to allow the various areas to flow seamlessly. The clients use the apartment for business entertaining and a 'conversation area' was created with soft seating near the bar area. The bar, with its detailing of leather panels, echoing the freestanding pieces, was highlighted with the use of exquisite alabaster panels, back lit which created a warm glow in the evenings. The colours of the leather and upholstery fabrics, whilst mainly neutral – grey/oyster & copper shades were set off with shots of colour in the jades and lapis fabrics, selected for their deep rich hues, used as bold punctuations and creating visual excitement, chosen

specifically to complement their wonderful collection of contemporary art and objet. The master bedroom, dressing room and en-suite, continued with the use of stitched leathers and sumptuous fabrics, with lighting effects setting off the details beautifully. The final delight is the cinema room, again using the same pallets and materials, with the cinema seating being centre stage with the jades and lapis velvets and a spectacular full wall of leather paneling and storage/cocktail bar.

The clients fell completely in love with the various pieces selected, "they are real works of art in their own right!". The result was a triumph!



SHANGHAI, CHINA

REVIVING REVOLUTION 1900s

The charm of this historical dwelling in Shanghai has been magnified by the refined decoration implemented by *Catherine Cheung*.

uildings in Shanghai have a rich history from the dying era of the Qing Dynasty (1644-1912). Colonial buildings built by the Europeans in the late 1800s, particularly during the controversial period of the French Concession (1849-1943), include structures designed and built by the Russian, British, American, Japanese, Portuguese, Italian and German architects. Surprisingly, most prominent buildings have survived both the Japanese occupation during WWII and the initial chaotic time of the communist regimen. In part this is because, unlike people from other parts of China, the Shanghainese embrace western lifestyle. They appreciate the western structures and work diligently to preserve buildings within the French Concession areas.

From an artistic perspective, this is a great opportunity to undertake an "East meets West" conservative project with a culturally induced element to an elegantly defined interior finished space, reflecting the European character of the subject. This is testament to enact and revitalize the lifestyle and culture of the revolution period of Shanghai during the 1900s.




THE XSS maximizes Coleccion Alexandra Heritage Classical furnishing to bring out the essence and aroma of the interior to transform the site back to the Shanghai-European era. Our main idea is to use the contrast to find a sophisticated and elegant style. We selected gold materials and dark colour fabrics in contrast with the light oriental wallpaper and decorations.

The combination of Coleccion Alexandra furniture and Chinese details brings out the classical European style living in the modern Shanghai. It creates a fusion atmosphere where east meets west. That contrast is the reason why this project is different, it is our Revolution.

The two story building (256 m2) was built by Isaiah Rogers during the late 19th Century in Huangpu District, which was situated inside the Shanghai-European Area, during the dying era of the Manchu (Qing) dynasty. Its colonial architectural and the surrounding neighbourhood share a rich European flavour in the middle of Shanghai.

HANOI IN OUR HEART


Original and elegant, yet highly functional. *Hoang Minh Tuan* has designed this stylish apartment in the heart of Hanoi.

anoi, the capital of Vietnam, is the centre of culture, politics, economy and trade for the whole country. Unlike the younger Saigon city (another famous city in Vietnam), Hanoi is a city with a very old established history. It is like a living body which is beautiful but whose form is shaped by the variability of the times. Now, the city is encompassed with the flowing and changing rhythms of contemporary life.

One of the most striking things about Vietnam's capital – Hanoi – is its architecture. The developing economy, as well as the process of international integration, along with the introduction of many different architectures have flowed into Hanoi to form a new architectural trend. Along with it, interior design is paid much attention to in Hanoi these days. People tend to invest more in their home to make it a really comfortable place where they feel inspired after working long hours outside.





This project is designed for a penthouse. The owner of this apartment is a business man who often travels to Europe on business. He loves the European style and thus he wants to experience a European living space in his own house.

The interior space of this apartment is decorated with neutral colors, strong contours combined with furniture which is selected thoroughly. The floor is granite in a dark colour, creating an interesting contrast. The grass wall in the living room is a highlight, making the space more luxurious.

That is there not to like about London The pulsating—everchanging vibe here. It is cool—frenetic but with a laid-back pace that oozes individuality and with an identity that is all its own. Architecturally a historic journey from palaces to cottages, from art deco excess to the simple glass edifices that line the Thames. I am into exquisitely made things that show that people care—when I stumbled (literally) on Coleccion Alexandra—I instinctively knew that this was a company who completely shared my ethos of design and people. Design is about an innate ability to unearth things wherever in the world they come from and tweak collaborate and work together to arrive at something which is perfect.


The "London project" with Coleccion Alexandra is located in Balham a hip district on the northern line. The client a busy creative was super specific about their expectation of the design outcome – "Cool, home and not architecturally "cheffy". A 170 m2 bungalow—large living space, adequate kitchen, 2.5 bedrooms, shower room and bathroom—surrounded by a courtyard garden it yearned to be developed into something that nodded "yes" to its past and "yes" to the present.

There was no question in my mind that to erase the building to the ground was not an option – it had a visual simplicity which is very conducive to an inventive interior. To dig another basement was explored - mining is not my thing – I deemed it too large an edifice for the plot – so after many sketches and exploration of space – a design evolved... 80 m2 of additional space on one level. A new wave bungalow. So, cool it would be, architecturally "cheffy" – not, and home definitely!

The spatial design is not another open plan crisis – it has been imagined in a series of retreats that are essential to the cocoon of modern living. 4 bedrooms – 3 bathrooms – vast kitchen – cavernous drawing room and a garden that was originally "black gothic" until white roses, formal bay trees softened with lilac, agapanthus, seas of snowdrops and miniature black pansies crept into the planting adding an Englishness to the look.

The interior has retained some of its original features! The over scale sash windows, comice mouldings, ceiling roses and deep skirting boards. The modern twist is the inclusion of huge 2.4 m. flat panelled doors, contemporary door furniture, a super sleek kitchen, baked and oiled oak floors and polished concrete.

The kitchen/dining room is sleek and ageless, matt white units, work tops in white Caesar stone contrasted with dark wood. The two islands were designed to veer away from the normal butcher block slab style affairs that grace so many contemporary kitchens. The wooden bridge allows a transparency of view making the space seem even larger and less utilitarian. The splash back and walls were constructed in Kolumba bricks hand made in Denmark by Peterson to add texture to the scheme. The floor is grey polished concrete installed by the innovative company – Top crete.



THE ULTIMATE FUNNY LONDON HOME THAT REFLECTS A COOL CONSIDERED INTERIOR THAT IS VERY VERY REAL. The Valentina dining table was commissioned to a custom size with a special baked oak top and the Nadine dining chairs chosen because of their elegant simplicity – hyped up with upholstery in canary and aubergine leather. The huge mezza Luna lights sourced from in-es design in Milan cast coloured moons of light around the room. The large limited edition lipstick photograph by Paul Krokos adds an amusing take to what is generally considered to be the workhorse part of a house.

The drawing room is divided from the kitchen by four sliding bookcases a versatile solution to allow seclusion or inclusion. A 1,5 m. ortal fireplace was shipped in from Israel to warm the focus flanked by duplicate seating areas to add symmetry and cohesion. The tailored design of the Sarah sofas and the Oslo chairs add a modern take on formal – "rooms cannot be all slouch and couch". The client had already purchased two stunning artworks from Bruges by the insanely talented artist Attisit pokpong

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

which led the directive here and interestingly drove the entire house design. Metres of oak floor softened by "ravage" rugs by Tai Ping define the conversation areas and the mirrored ghost coffee tables used to complete the glamorous look. The lighting simple – floor and table lamps from CTO and a quirky chandelier from The Interiors House. The bedroom is a dripping nod to boudoir – gold on grey encrusted wallpaper from The Interiors house in London, A huge glistening seed cloud chandelier from Ochre. The bespoke black lacquered bed and compass bedside cabinets from Coleccion Alexandra create luxury at its max. The regal Spock armchair was covered in Madam visage velvet by Santorus and with the Lauren desk lacquered in black gloss to finish off this up- beat space. Of course, it is always the little touches that define a fabulous project – we spend an in ordinate amount of time seeking out those special details we fell in love with these jaw-dropping beautiful handbags from Hamish Menzies whose company Rocio in Glasgow makes them. The ultimate funny London home that reflects a cool considered interior that is very very real.



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ocated in Nanshan District, Shenzhen, China Resources Shenzhen Bay features outstanding geological and landscape advantages. Abutting the 15km-long coastal long aisle and home to the front coastal scene, it also presents a place for people to relish in the vibrancy and exuberance of mother nature, in the mangrove ecological park encircled by shades. Therefore, the concept of 'city garden' is set up at the very outset when designing the sample project in the hope that it can cut off city noise and fatigue. The essence of spatial designing is to bestow senses, respectively sense of respect, sense of nobility, sense of security, sense of comfort and sense of joy. Rather than being stacked up with luxurious materials, it keeps an eye on the transcendence of the five senses on the physical level. It attempts to demonstrate 'nobility' with respect to people and a natural life style.

So in space molding, it chooses the most natural wood and stone as the major materials. The space as a whole also adopts ground coloUr series with a large area of white for ceiling and wall prevailing.

The hallway at the entrance skillfully separates the drawing room and restaurant into independent partitions. The space 'separated but uninterrupted' adopted for the whole room demonstrates the essence of taste, spirits and life. The hallway, guestroom and dining room can be converted to a place for parties to receive friends and relatives to share delicacies. It is a place for communication with people that does not focus on styles. Internal glamour for dwelling of great wealth is of paramount importance. We should resemble butterflies in living a graceful life and handle all particularities with an aesthetic mindset. 'Wealth' comes out of cultural deposits.

The interesting partition in the hallway at the entrance adds more vibrancy and natural sentiments to life. Rather than choosing highly-decorative furniture, the living room opts for graceful lines and stresses texture and sense of touch of cloth so that the overall space is tranquil and noble. Furniture in the restaurant takes black as the keynote, the black glass droplight demonstrates more mystery and magnificence with its smooth texture contrasting its stone material while luxury or aggressiveness is shunned. 


BARCELONA, SPAIN

Passing through the threshold to a reception area one can enjoy a panoramic view of the whole interior through a large glass partition, mainly the living/dining room.




RIYADH, SAUDI ARABIA

CONTEMPORARY LOFT IN RIYADH

The project for this private residence in Riyadh was entirely conceived and developed by *Carrillo Proyectos*, under the supervision of *Laura Carrillo*.

he client was keen on creating a divergent space far from the traditional style in terms of aesthetics and also living conditions. A more avant-garde style was asked for while also maintaining a level of comfort and convenience. The key was to create a versatile and harmonious ambience, blending both concepts inspired by large industrial spaces. Following these guidelines, the dwelling was designed as two separate areas although interconnected but with no visual barriers, totally open plan, to create a multifunctional space. The iron spiral staircase, connecting the two levels is highlighted as a decorative sculptural element.

Each detail of the project has been the object of careful study. Lighting has played an important part becoming a key element to achieve the desired atmosphere and ambience of a loft (skylights and playing with different levels); as well as the choice of rudimentary materials, like exposed brick in the living room and master bedroom; iron for the pillars and the staircase handrail; steel for the kitchen and the exposed ventilation ducts. These industrial elements have been combined with other softer materials such as wood for the flooring and a careful selection of exclusive furniture pieces by Coleccion Alexandra as well as elegant fabrics and wall coverings.


WORLD-CLASS DESIGN WITH A HINT OF TRADITION, Energize the Well-being

The penthouse was one level with high ceilings and three bedrooms. A mezzanine level was added to create a large master suite, plus two bedrooms while keeping an additional guest bedroom on the lower level.




